LOCATION

Uppingham is an historic Market Town with a population of approx 4000, also supporting a large rural catchment. The town is located just off the A47 equidistant from Peterborough and Leicester, each about 20 miles away. The property occupies a prominent retail position on High Street East between Timpson and Culpin's Butchers.

ACCOMMODATION

Attractive, stone, ground floor lock up shop with dual display windows fronting High Street East. In all 186 sq ft to the ground floor.

Rear stairs to a full height and entirely useable basement office/storage with kitchen and wc. 152 sq ft in all.

Ground and basement are heated via wall mounted electric space heaters.

From the rear stairs access to the first floor there is an L-shaped room of around 157 sq ft with a further kitchen area and a usable under-stairs cupboard. Off the first floor landing there is a w/c and a shower cubicle.

Stairs to the 2nd floor and two further rooms totalling 180 sq ft.

All the upper floors are served by gas fired radiator heating. The whole of the accommodation has been converted to a pleasing standard and the upper floors are separately metered, are capable of separate access, and thereby of separate use.
